

Work to begin on Cary Metra improvements

Starting Monday, work will begin at the northwest end of the platform of the Cary Metra Station as part of the improvements to replace the existing stairs leading to the commuter parking lot with a new accessible pedestrian ramp.

This will require the temporary closure of the stairway that leads down to the platform. Metra commuters using the north parking lot should give themselves a few extra minutes to reach the inbound platform, as all pedestrians will be required to cross the tracks at the West Main Street crossing.

The work is anticipated to last approximately two months. During the closure, detours will be stationed to assist commuters in traveling between the platform and north commuter parking lot.

This work is the first step of the overall Cary Metra Station and pedestrian crossing improvements. Later this summer, the construction of the new depot building and warming shelter will begin in partnership with Metra. Utility work will begin behind the inbound platform Wednesday.
