On November 27, 2018 at 2:06 am, the Cary Police Department responded to 296 Cary Algonquin Road for the report of an Armed Robbery. The suspect was described as a **male, white, approximately 5'6", between 30 and 35 years of age, with black dot tattoos or circular dermal piercings on each side of his chin, wearing square dark frame glasses, black leather jacket, grey sweatpants and grey shoes.**

A review of the store video indicated the suspect displayed a silver/white handgun and demanded money from the store clerk. The clerk complied and gave him the available currency from the register. The suspect then fled on foot, in an unknown direction, with a brown 7-Eleven bag containing the stolen currency. No one was injured during the incident and the case remains under investigation by the Cary Police Department.
