On 12/17/18 at approximately 0200 hrs., The above pictured subject climbed through a drive-thru window of the McDonald's at 678 Northwest Highway in Cary, Illinois. Upon entering the establishment, the offender demanded currency from the register. He was given an unknown amount of United States currency and fled through the same drive-thru window. The subject was described as a male, white, early 20's, unknown height and weight, wearing a light colored cloth across his face, dark blue hooded sweatshirt, khaki (tan) colored tight pants along with gray in colored 'Chuck Taylor' styled shoes. The suspect also has a tattoo on his left index finger that looks like the numeral 1. No weapon was implied or displayed and no one was injured during the incident. The case remains under investigation by the Cary Police Department.
