Cary to Annex 180 Acres of Park Land

Cary, (February 4, 2008): The Cary Village Board is set to consider for approval Tuesday night an annexation agreement with the Cary Park District. "We are happy to bring the east side of the Hoffman Park property into the Village of Cary," stated Steve Lamal, Mayor. "We've wanted to bring the 180-acre piece of land into Cary for quite some time and we're happy to partner with the Park District to make it happen," concluded Mayor Lamal.

The Cary Park District owns the 270-acre Hoffman Park property that extends from Cary-Algonquin Road west to Route 31. The 180-acre eastern portion of the larger park had previously been in the Village of Lake in the Hills. By agreement, the 180 acres was de-annexed from Lake in the Hills and will now, after action Tuesday evening, be located in Cary. The Cary Park District is planning to develop recreational facilities and areas on the 180-acre parcel in Cary. "Residents who border the eastern 180-acre portion of the Hoffman Park property have wanted the property in Cary," stated Village Administrator Cameron Davis. "The addition of 180 acres of park land to the already significant park and open space areas currently within the corporate boundaries of Cary certainly adds to the Village's reputation as a great quality of life community," concluded Administrator Davis.

The Village Board meeting will be held Tuesday night at Village Hall, 655 Village Hall Drive, Cary.
