On Saturday January 11, 2020 at approximately 5:24 a.m. Cary Police Officers responded to a burglar alarm that was activated at a business in the 100 block of East Main Street. Upon arrival, officers discovered entry was forced to the business.

Review of video surveillance from the business revealed that three black males forced entry into the business, stole various electronics estimated at approximately \$7,800, and left the scene eastbound on U.S. Route 14.

The suspects fled the scene in a silver GMC Yukon with North Carolina registration FLW 2349. It is also believed there was a fourth suspect who remained in the vehicle during the burglary. Please see the attached photographs for suspect and vehicle descriptions.
